In light of their initial Memorandum of Understanding (MoU), dated 7 September 2016, which was due to expire, the World Organisation for Animal Health (OIE) and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) have decided to continue their collaboration through a <a href="mailto:new MoU">new MoU</a>, which replaces the initial MoU. The new MoU was signed on 31 August 2018 for a five-year term and extends the areas of collaboration to potential activities focusing on best practices, policies and economic evaluations to enhance the quality, effectiveness and impact of international standards.
